We also did brainstorming on recommendation for the VET centres and VET system in general. All presentations and discussions were quite useful and interesting.

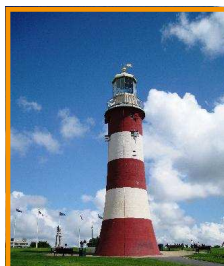


## Having fun...
